

CBST-USAS evaluations are by appointment. The next opportunity to join the team is for the long course 2025 season which begins in mid-April. **The deadline to request an evaluation is Wednesday, January 15th.** If you would like to inquire about an evaluation for your swimmer, please make contact per below at your earliest convenience and no later than January 15th, noting that if you wait until the deadline to make contact you will have fewer evaluation options.

Basic information about evaluations:

Evaluations for our USA Swimming team, CBST-USAS, are used to make sure that the swimmer is ready for the rigorous practices of this team. Evaluations typically consist of swimmers swimming all four strokes and some mini sets on time intervals to see which practice group would be the best fit. Our coaches need to be sure that swimmers are able to swim all four competitive strokes legally (the strokes are freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke, and butterfly). The coaches must determine if the group a swimmer is ready for ability-wise is also appropriate age-wise so that it will be a productive environment for everyone.

Be sure your swimmer knows that it is fine if they are not evaluated as ready for this team right now or if they are placed in a group other than what they expected. For most kids if it's set up for them as just deciding what is best, rather than "making" the team or a particular group they are fine with any outcome. They can always join the team later when they're ready and group advancement happens as appropriate throughout each season. We want to help children become life-long swimmers and are looking for the best placement to help them based on what they need at this point in time.
